The 'Eight Essentials' are

ALWAYS...

Organise your stores to be locked, dry and signed appropriately.

Permit only qualified people to access and use the product.

Ensure you obtain and wear the correct PPE/RPE.

Read the label before you start and then follow the directions for use.

Apply only through the specified applicators and never by hand.

Treat only rabbits, rats and moles and never any other animals.

Orders and use the right quantities needed for each job beforehand.

Recap flasks only if they are completely empty, dust-free and ready for disposal.
